

WOLVERHAMPTON SC SPRINT MEET

This is a Level 3 Licensed Meet for entry into County and Regional Competitions

ENTRY TO THIS MEET WILL BE ON A FIRST COME FIRST SERVED BASIS

VENUE	Central Baths, Wolverhampton
POOL	8 Lane - 25m pool - electronic timing - anti turbulence lane ropes
AGE GROUPS	9 yrs; 10 yrs; 11 yrs; 12 yrs; 13 yrs; 14 yrs; 15 yrs; Open
AGE UP DATE	Age will be age as at 11 th July 2010 (being the date of the meet)
EVENTS	50m All strokes - all age groups 100m Freestyle - 10 yrs upwards 100m Breaststroke - 10 yrs upwards 100m Backstroke - 10 yrs upwards 100m Butterfly - 10 yrs upwards 100m IM - all age groups

All events will be on a `Heat Declared` basis.

PROMOTERS CONDITIONS

PROMOTER	The promoter of the Wolverhampton SC Sprint Meet is Wolverhampton Swimming Club. (WSC)
AWARDS	Awards will be given to the top 3 in each age category. There will be additional awards for Top Boy and Top girl. There will be a perpetual trophy awarded to the Top Visiting Club. Points will be awarded:- 1 st (8pts); 2 nd (7pts); 3 rd (6pts); 4 th (5pts); 5 th (4pts); 6 th (3pts); 7 th (2pts); 8 th (1pt)
ENTRIES	Qualifying and upper cut off times will be applied in all events. All entry times must be between the QT and UQT. Times will be based just below County Age Group Qualification (QT) and just above Regional Qualifications (UCT). In the event that an individual event is oversubscribed, entries will be accepted on a first come first served basis.

Entry fee will be £3.50 per event. Closing date for entries will be 7th June 2010. Cheques should be made payable to Wolverhampton Swimming Club. Entry forms, together with full payment to:-

STARTS Over the top starts may be used.

RESULTS Results will appear on Wolverhampton Swimming Club's website within 72 hours of the meet closing. Results will be submitted to the ASA. Any Club wishing to receive an electronic copy of the results must submit a relevant email address at the time of submitting entries.

CAR PARKING Free car parking is available at Central Baths, but spaces are limited and available on a first come first served basis.

SPECTATORS Entry £6.00 for a full day pass, to include programme and a raffle ticket. Children under 5 years free.

REFRESHMENTS A Refreshment van will be in attendance during the meet selling hot/cold drinks and also hot food. Various vending machines are also located in the leisure centre.

COACHES PASSES A maximum for 2 coaches passes may be purchased per club at a cost of £10.00 per pass, to include full set of results and lunch. Applications for additional passes can be made, subject to, and at the discretion of the Meet Promoter. Passes must be worn at all times, and must be purchased in advance. No poolside passes will be available for purchase on the day of the meet.

There will be no access to the poolside for anyone who does not have a poolside pass.

OFFICIALS

If visiting clubs can provide any qualified officials, then this would be much appreciated. Lunch and refreshments will be provided.

SWIM SHOP

A swim shop will be in operation throughout the meet.

GENERAL
