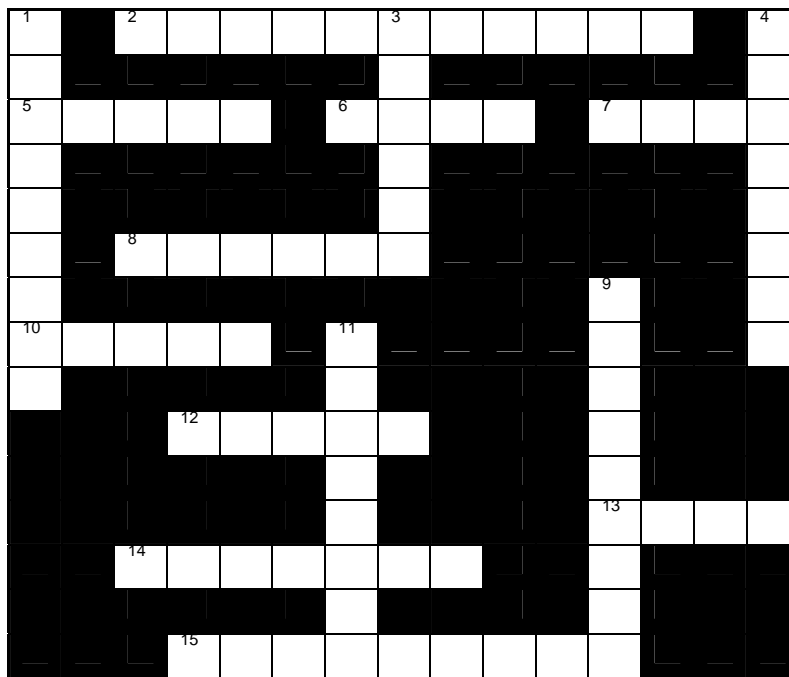
### SPONSORED SWIM
